Screen saver for the 2nd device must be set to off. Video and microphone must be ON at all times when the player is in the Zoom meeting room.

	3. Player are advised not to go to the washroom during the game without the			
	permission from the online arbiter and ONLY on the opponent's move			
	4. In case of emergency i. player should raise one hand and face the zoom camera ii. arbiter to call the player's name iii. player can leave the camera for washroom (preferably not more than a minute)
